




It registers automatically exact margins for filling in work or for handling blanks of varied sizes.






HE Paper Fingers of the New Model OLIVER Typewriter are really fingers.

Another marvelous advance in typewriter construction.




HE Balance-Shifting Mechanism of The OLIVER Typewriter is here portrayed.

The entire weight of the carriage is sustained by the pendulums (at either end) on which it swings.


